Gig Review: Album Launch party, 18th October 2019

It's a Friday night and I find myself stood at the back of Studio 2 Parr Street next to the sound desk. The best place to take it all in, to just watch and listen to everything going on. Cal seems to have attracted a full house so after a quick sound check the band open up the night and the crowd are lifted.

The band are excellent musicians, technically competent, there's no egos getting in the way. It seems they just want to deliver the songs and to do it well. Cal's vocal is a standout, it's honest, melodic and drives home the true essence of storytelling, it sounds effortless, it just 'is'.

The songs have a certain rawness, they evoke meaning, you're sucked in whether you want to be or not. They tell you a story, this in effect captures the attention of the crowd from start to finish.
